



SORTING INSTRUCTIONS



BIO WASTE

All food waste from your household kitchen.

- ✓ Fish guts and vegetable peels, used coffee filters, coffee grounds, teabags, tissues and napkins, food leftovers, flower soils.

No thanks: Liquids.



PAPER

All the paper from your household mailbox

- ✓ Newspapers and magazines, advertisements and brochures, envelopes (including those with windows), white copy and drawing paper, product and service catalogues.

No thanks: Wet or dirty paper, brown paper bags, soft tissues, cardboard package, gift wrapping paper.



METAL PACKAGING

Empty metal packaging and small metal items from the household.

- ✓ Tins, non-deposit beverage cans, metal lids, caps and closures, aluminium trays, foil and covers, paint cans, non-pressure aerosol cans and metal coffee capsules.
- ✓ Pots and pans, cutlery, scissors and tools, other small metal objects (nails, screws, fittings, etc.) and aluminium tealight cups.

No thanks: Packages that contain remains of hazardous waste.



PLASTIC PACKAGING

Empty plastic packaging from the household.

- ✓ Plastic food packaging, detergent packaging, other household plastic packaging, bottles and jars, take-away food containers and packaging and single-use cups.
- ✓ Plastic bags, pouches and wrappers, styrofoam packaging and other plastic fillers.
- ✓ Place caps, lids, pump parts and similar items that can be easily removed by hand in the collection container separately.

No thanks: Packages that contain remains of hazardous waste, plastic products (toys, buckets etc.) or very dirty plastics.



CARTON PACKAGING

Empty cardboard packaging from the household

- ✓ Cardboard beverage cartons, cardboard packaging for food and other products, paper bags, paper sacks, wrapping paper, toilet and kitchen roll tubes, pizza boxes and egg cartons.
- ✓ Takeaway food containers and packaging, disposable cups, cardboard boxes, cardboard and paper packing fillers.
- ✓ Please flatten the packaging!

No thanks: Damp or dirty cartons.

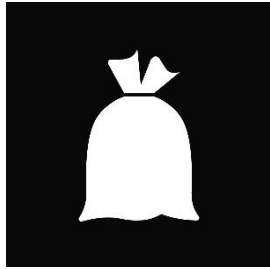


GLASS PACKAGING

Empty glass packaging from the household.

- ✓ Glass bottles and glass jars.
- ✓ With caps and lids removed.
- ✓ Collars and labels do not need to be removed.

No thanks: Glass tableware, porcelain, ceramics, crystal, window or mirror glass, lamps and lighting fixtures or packages that contain remains of hazardous waste.



MIXED WASTE

Non-recyclable waste from the household.

- ✓ Dirty plastic packages, broken plastic products, ash and cigarettes, diapers and sanitary napkins, pet feces, vacuum cleaner bags.

No thanks: recyclable waste, construction and renovation waste, large objects, furniture, electronic equipment or hazardous waste.



Hazardous waste, electronic equipment (SER) and batteries must be taken to the Antinkorpi waste station (Orivedentie 367, 17800 Kuhmoinen).

Pharmaceutical waste must be taken to the pharmacy.

If incorrectly sorted, some types of waste, such as batteries and electrical and electronic equipment, can cause fires and other hazardous situations.

Recycle deposit plastic and glass bottles and metal cans using a reverse vending machine at a shop.
